

Dealing with Crisis

Students who are experiencing a crisis and need help are encouraged to visit either the Counseling and Advising Center at the college (360-538-4099) or the Behavioral Health Resources Crisis Clinic at 615 8th Street in Hoquiam. The clinic is open 24 hours per day, 7 days per week for free walk-in services.

Students experiencing a domestic violence situation are encouraged to visit the Domestic Violence Center at 2306 Sumner Avenue in Hoquiam (1-800-562-6025). The Center is free to all victims of domestic violence and is open Monday-Friday from 8-12 and 1-5 p.m.

Students who have been sexually assaulted are encouraged to visit Beyond Survival (360-533-9751). Beyond Survival is open Monday-Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and provides free services to victims of sexual assault and abuse.
